PARKING

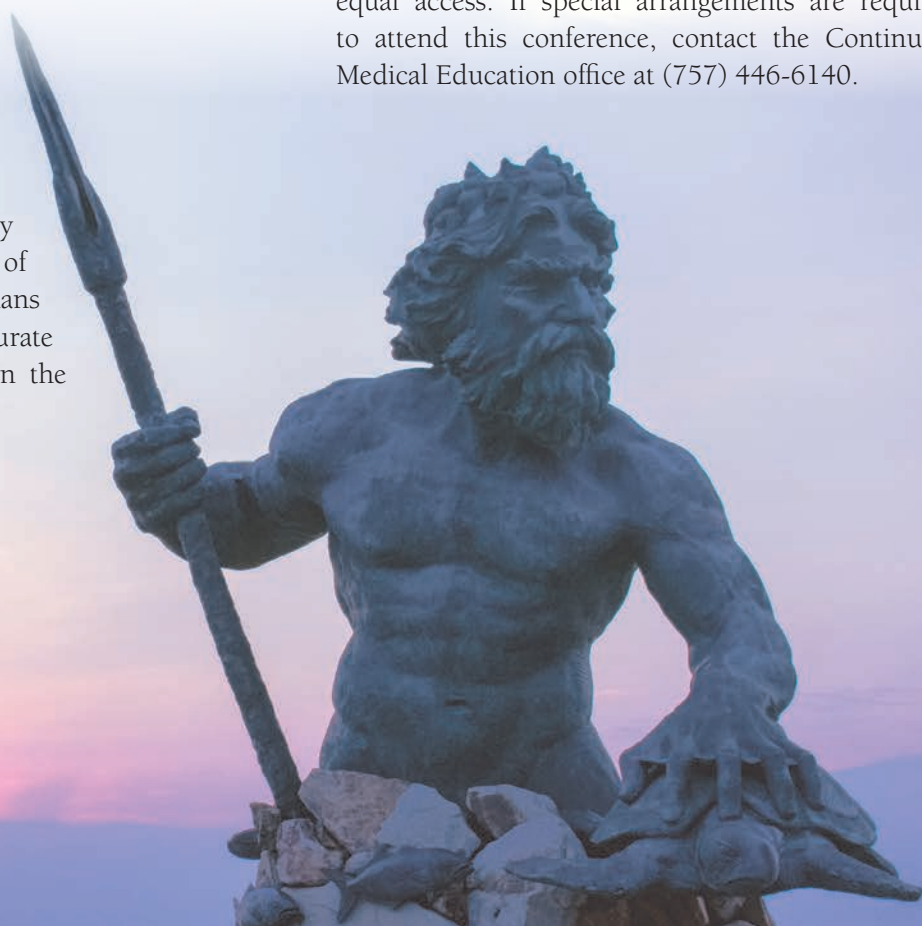
