Alexander Westphal, MD, PhD, is a psychiatrist fellowship training in child and adolescent, and forensic psychiatry. He has a clinical and research interest in the population with developmental and intellectual disabilities. Dr. Westphal has been at Yale Child Study Center since 2005 as a trainee and a research fellow, and with the Yale’s Division of Law and Psychiatry since 2011, where he is currently an Associate Professor. He is particularly interested in the evaluation of criminal offenders with developmental and intellectual disabilities, and in the assessment and management of violence risk in the same population. His current duties include risk assessment of insanity acquittees for the State of Connecticut, psychiatric oversight of a network of group homes and schools for autism, consultation to legal professionals on autism, and a variety of teaching and administrative duties associated with Yale’s Division of Law and Psychiatry.
