Statement of Need: Knowledge deficits affect the proper treatment and evaluation of patients with neurological disorders such as stroke, epilepsy, neuromuscular diseases, multiple sclerosis, Alzheimer's and Parkinson's disease. These diseases are common in the general population, and they are a major cause of disability, especially among older individuals. The medical care of patients with neurological disorders is often provided by primary care and family physicians, internists, geriatricians, and other non-neurologists. As knowledge in neuroscience is rapidly growing, novel diagnostic tools and treatment interventions have been developed that have significantly improved the care of neurological patients. This educational program will inform participants of best practice and novel interventions for neurological disorders, addressing the knowledge and practice gap of non-neurologists caring for neurological disorders.

Program Objectives: All Northwell Health CME activities are intended to improve patient care, safety and outcomes. At the conclusion of this conference participants should be able to:

Identify new treatment parameters and novel treatment strategies for patients with neurological disorders.
