Statement of need: Recent developments and advancements in the field of obstetrics and gynecology have resulted in the need to update clinicians on a variety of topics including fetal therapy, treatment of congenital gynecological anomalies, endometriosis, incontinence and pelvic organ prolapse. There have also been recent updates in management of hemorrhage, ovarian cryopreservation, labor inductions, therapies for menopause, endometrial cancer, PCOS and SSI prevention. In addition, there is a need for OB/GYN clinicians to improve their knowledge and skills in ultrasound. There is a need to integrate this material into practice through the exchange of knowledge and discussion in the OB/GYN clinical community.
