

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Statement of need: Identification of strokes and acute treatment of ischemic stroke with a focus on new indications for mechanical thrombectomy. Use of intracerebral hemorrhage code to improve outcomes and treatment role of neurology with cardiology and the secondary prevention of stroke. Treatment and management of small aneurysms and successful strategies to reduce readmissions for stroke. Focusing on women and the impact of stroke in vulnerable populations.
